Allium — Purple Sensation

Allium aflatunense

Beautiful, perennial, affordable. Purple Sensation bears 4-inch globes of rich purple flowers on tall stems. It is early for an allium; blooms on the heels of late tulips. Can be massed or planted in clusters in a perennial border. Deer resistant.

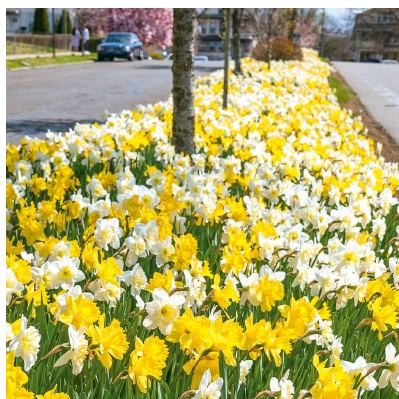
Daffodil — Golden Delicious (double)

Narcissus 'Golden Delicious'

Double yellow flowers borne in pairs (sometimes threes). What makes them "delicious" is their fragrance, which is light and sweet. You can stoop to enjoy it, or you can save your knees by cutting a few stems and bringing them indoors. Deer and rodent proof.

Height 14-16" • Bulb size 12-14cm • Colorblends item 3811 (catalog p. 105)

Naturalizing Daffodil — The Gold Shoulder

Narcissus blend, introduced 1997

A blend of tough, dependable daffodils, one gold, one white with a yellow cup that turns ivory. Given half a day of sun or more and well-drained soil, the bulbs can increase their number from year to year. Excellent for landscaping and low-maintenance plantings. Deer and rodent proof.

Hyacinth — Purple Sensation

Hyacinthus orientalis

Dense clusters of fragrant, rich purple blooms—lighter at the margins—on thick stems. There's no need to stoop to detect the scent of a hyacinth; it comes to you.

Hyacinth — Jambalaya Blend

Hyacinth blend, introduced 2006

A spicy blend of five different hyacinths in bright, clear colors. They look tasty and smell heavenly. Plant closely in a large bed or sprinkle them in bunches through the landscape. You really can't go wrong.

Grape Hyacinth — Blue

Muscari armeniacum

Grape Hyacinths produce several dense spikes of tiny, true blue flowers from each bulb. They are beautiful on their own, but their greatest value may be as companions to midseason tulips. That rich blue makes almost any tulip color pop.

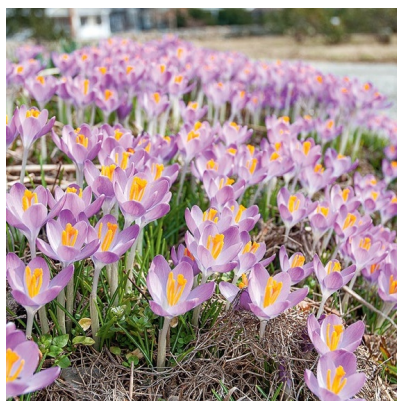
Tulip Blend — Mucho Gusto (double)

Tulip blend of 4 varieties, introduced 2023

A sumptuous blend of large-flowered double tulips in various shades of yellow and red. They offer the kind of embrace you get from a good friend you haven't seen in years—warm, inviting, satisfying.

Height 16–20" • Bulb size 12cm+ • Colorblends item 1487 (catalog p. 33)

Tommies Crocuses (early)

Crocus tommasinianus 'Barr's Purple'

Purplish pink Tommies bring an elfin charm to the garden in late winter or early spring. A delightful, early, and very affordable crocus. Flowers prolifically in most situations, and likes to come back year after year.

Height 3-4" • Bulb size 5-7cm • Colorblends item 6024 (catalog p. 127)

Amaryllis — Splash (double)

Hippeastrum 'Splash' — indoor winter bloomer

An eye-popping double bicolor with blooms that are about 7 inches wide. The tapered petals are held neatly one over the other, and the contrast between the red and white is striking. It's hard to believe the flowers are real.

Height 20-30" • Bulb size 32-34cm • Colorblends item 7080 (catalog p. 145)
